The BNP have stood for elections in Lewisham in the past but not recently. Unfortunately the same is not true in other parts of London. This year they gained 12 council seats in Barking and Dagenham.

The GLA elections in 2008 are by proportional representation, so the BNP could gain Assembly seats in London. It has been shown that where fascist groups have a higher profile there is an increase in racist attacks. Getting elected gives them a platform to spread their politics of race hate.

How can we keep the BNP out of Lewisham? How can we help to defeat them in other parts of London?
