Stop the fascist BNP — use your vote on 4 May

The British National Party (BNP) hopes to gain council seats in 4 May local government elections. They may stand candidates in your area. Here are reasons why they must be stopped.

1. **The BNP is a Nazi organisation**

The BNP attempts to pose as a “respectable” political party. Several documentaries in recent years have exposed the BNP as a Hitler admiring, white supremacist organisation.

2. **The BNP has terrorist and criminal connections**

David Copeland, who carried out the London nail bombings in Brixton, Brick Lane and Soho in 1999 said: “My aim was political. It was to cause a racial war... then all the white people would go and vote BNP”

3. **The BNP is racist**

The BNP want an all-white Britain. Racist attacks and violence increase in areas the BNP target. In the year a BNP councillor was elected in Barking and Dagenham, east London, racist attacks increased by 18%, and by 84% in nearby Havering.

4. **The BNP denies the Holocaust**

The BNP have described the Holocaust as a “Holohoax.” In total 15 million Jews, trade unionists, gypsies, Slavs, black, lesbian, gay and disabled people were murdered as a result of Nazi Germany’s murderous policies.

If elected the BNP spread their message of hatred and division.

But the BNP can be defeated. The BNP have been systematically defeated in council by-elections since September 2004 because **people used their vote** to stop them getting elected.
